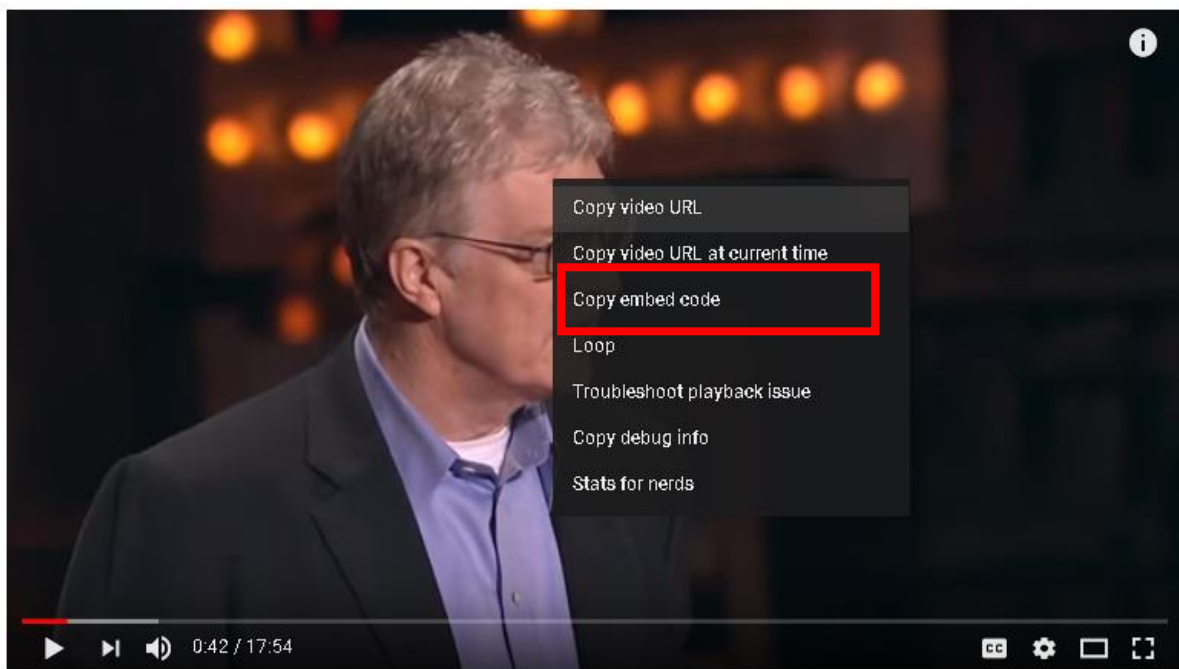
TUTORIAL: EMBED VIDEO OR AUDIO FILES



The LMS allows you to upload varied media source and there are different way in which you can use the tools in LMS to add them.

Below is a step-by-step guide on how to embed videos from YouTube into your module.

Step 1: Go to YouTube and locate the video you wish to place in your course. Right click on the video and select the option that says copy embed code.

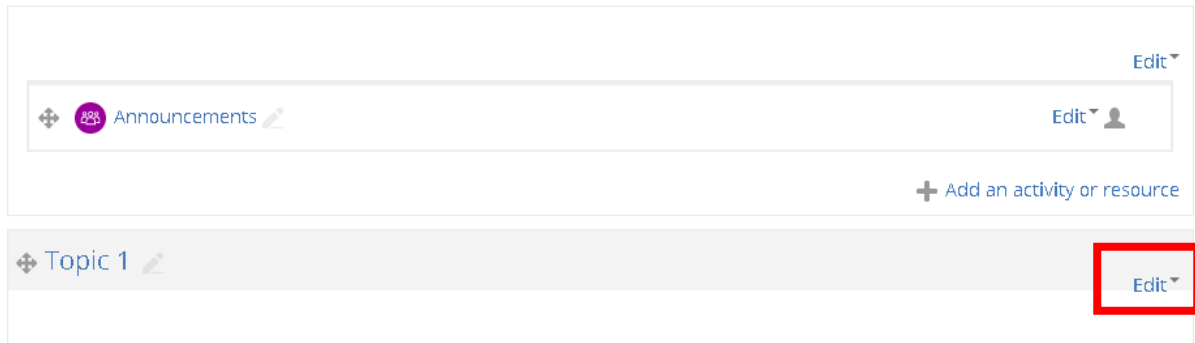
This copies the video location.

Step 2: Go back to your Module and turn editing on by clicking on the green button in the menu block to **Turn editing on**.



If you cannot see the option to do this at the top right of menu block, you will need to request Teacher (Editor) access from the Course Facilitator.

Step 3: Select a location for the video (usually a page) or click on the topic (section) edit button if you want to add the video to the topic overview.

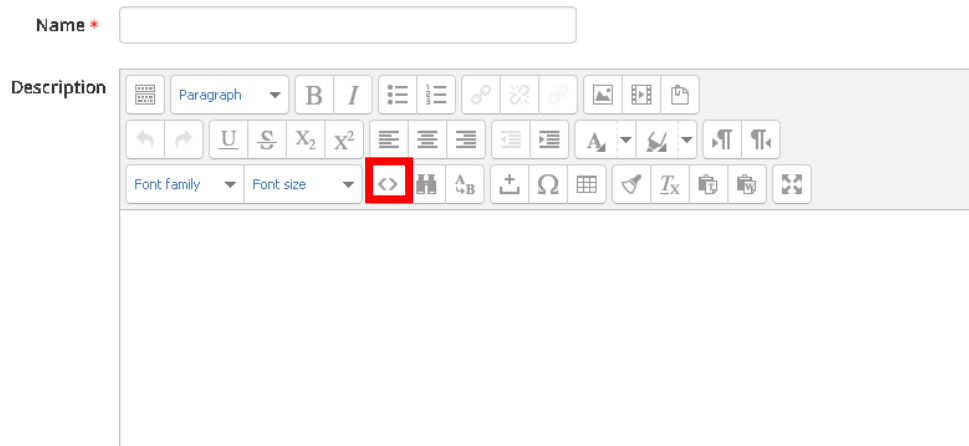


Step 4: Click on the Toolbar toggle button  to expand the toolbar and then select the **html source**  icon.

Step 5: Scroll down to **select files** section on course page. In the file **Content** area, you can add files using two options.

Option one is using the Add file menu.

Step 6: Right Click and paste the video embed code that you had copied from YouTube.

Step 7: Click on update and save the changes that you have made. The video will then appear on your course as below. Students can play it within Moodle or on Youtube as required.
