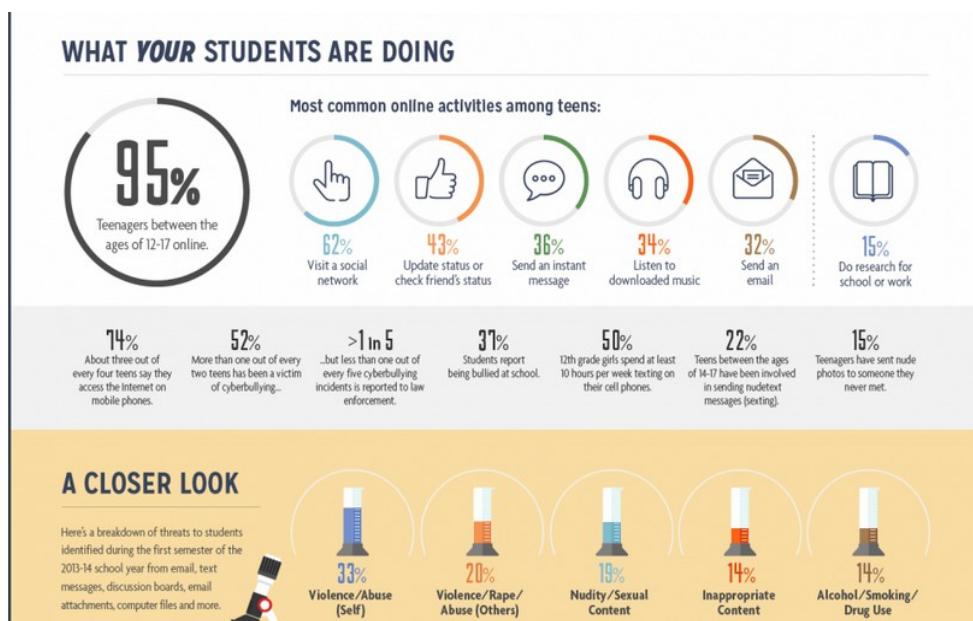
Student Online Protection
